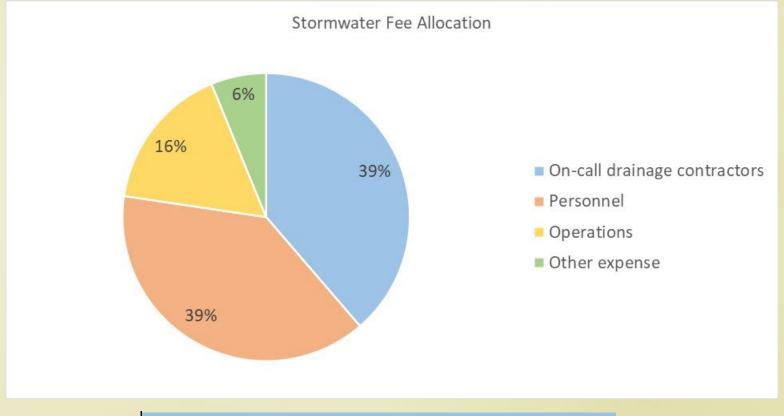

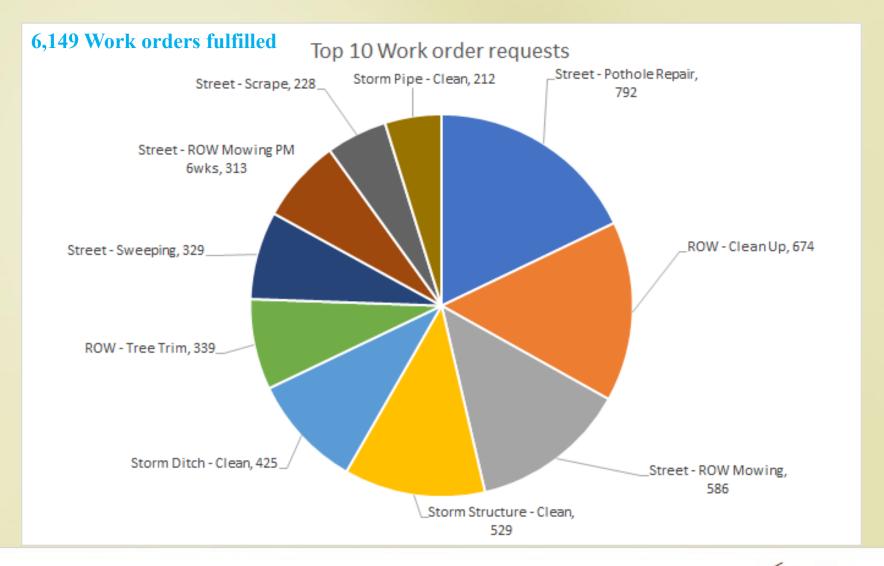

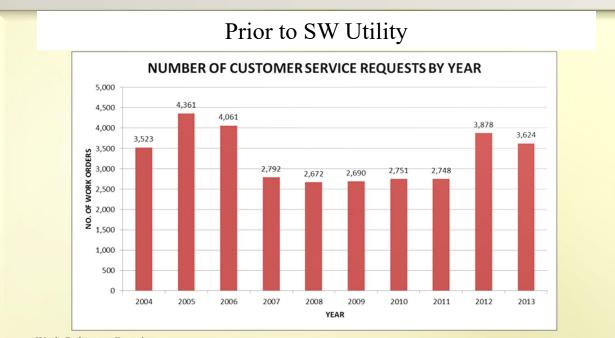

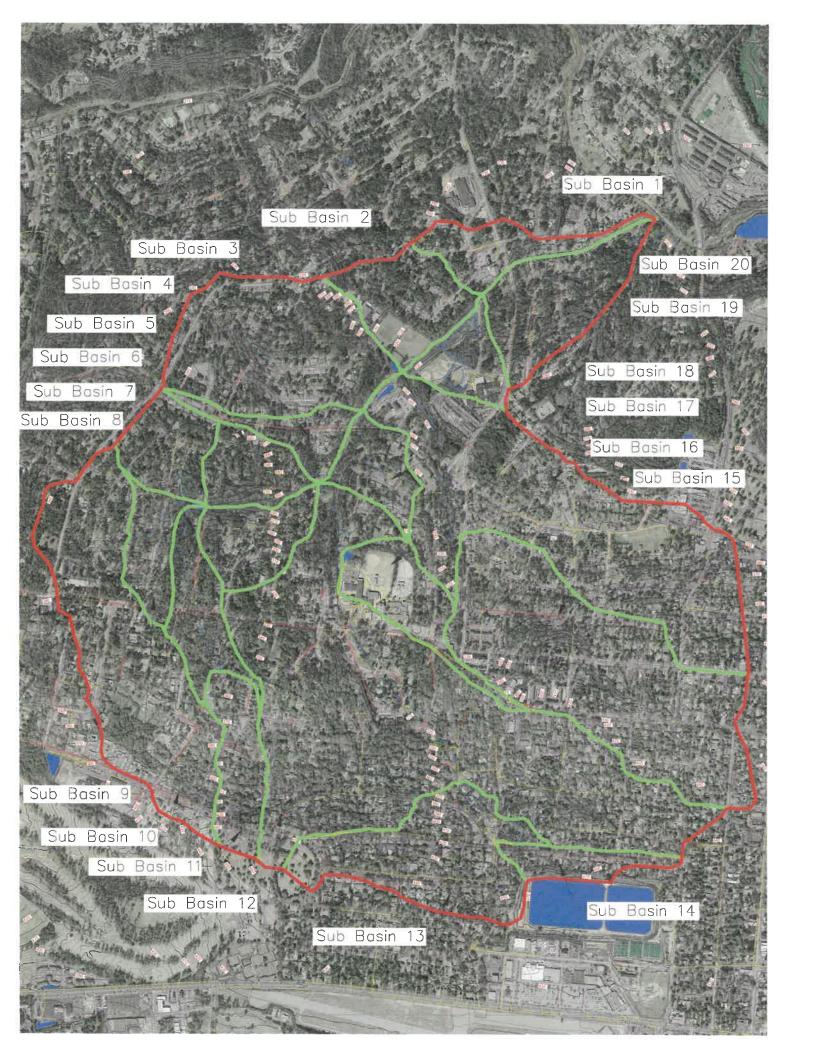
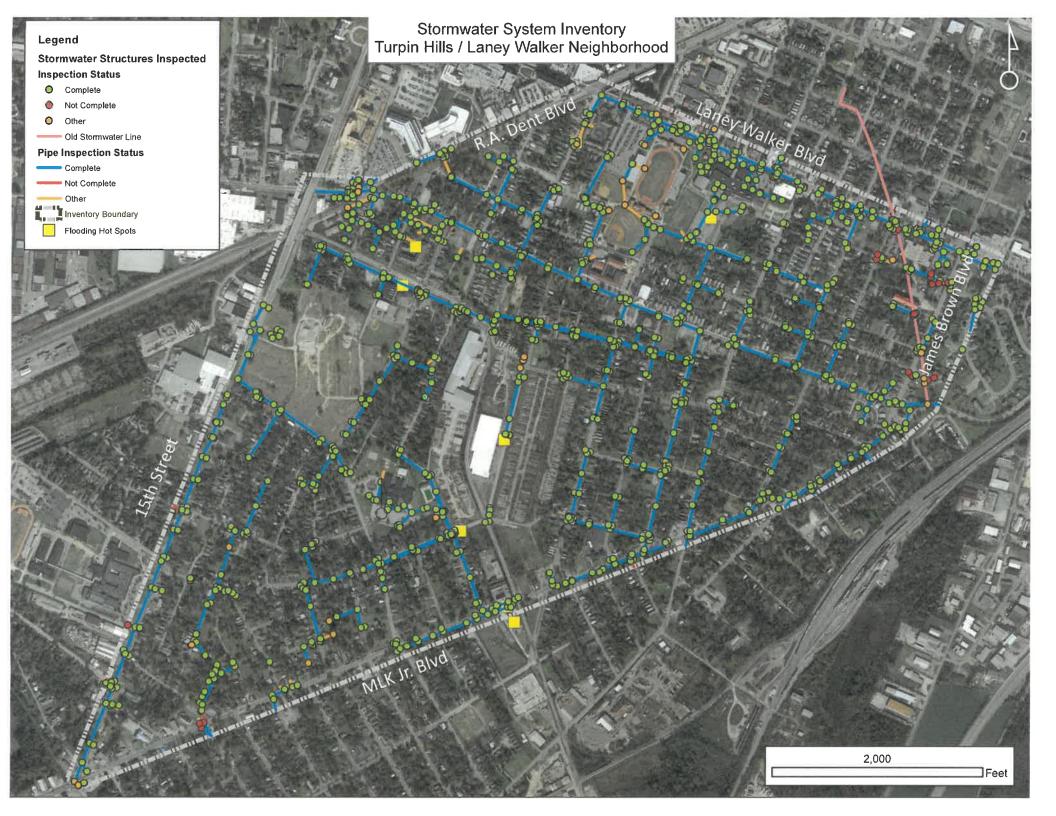


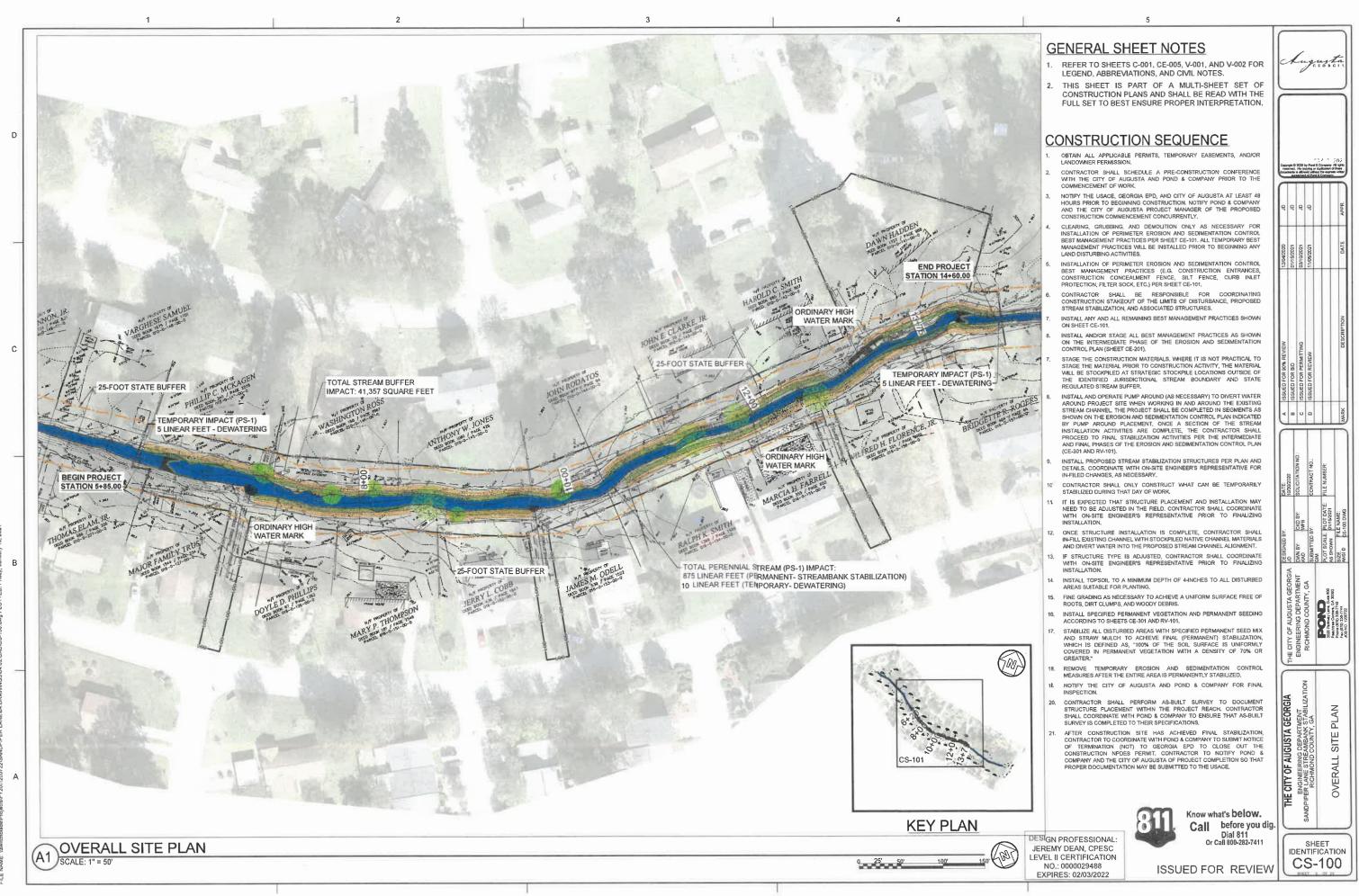


Figure 2: Summary of Goshen Subbasins









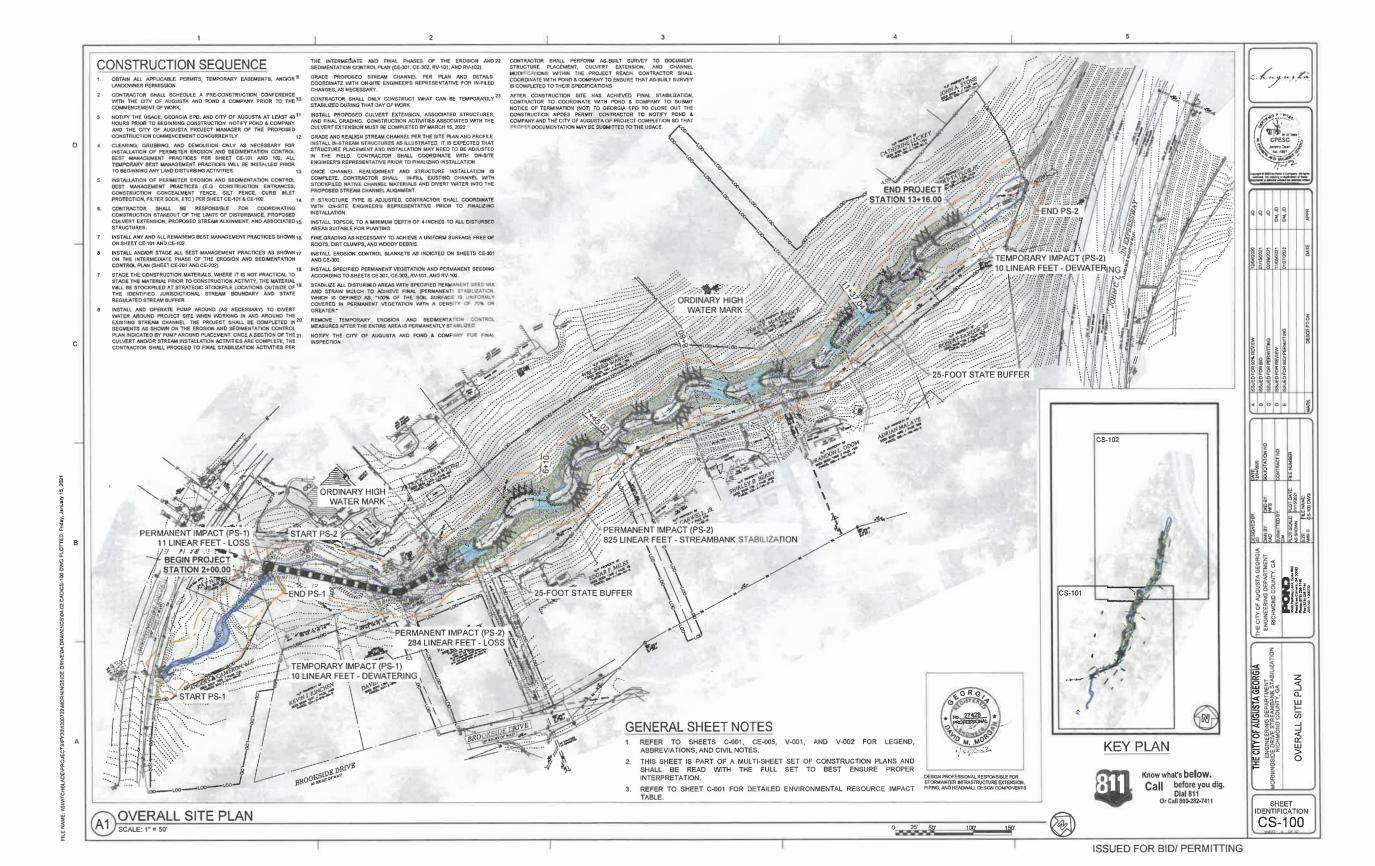
